#### 1.1 About us

Amal Jyothi College of Engineering (AJCE), Kanjirappally has established itself as a benchmark of excellence in technical higher education, research and extension. Founded in 2001 by the Catholic Diocese of Kanjirappally, AJCE is one of the most sought after colleges for engineering studies. With an annual intake of 1140 in 9 B.Tech., 7 M.Tech. and 3 MCA programs, AJCE tops the list based on annual intake. B.Tech. in Automobile Engineering was started in 2009. The built-up area is 14 lakh sq.ft including hostels in an area of sixty-five acres. AJCE is approved by the AICTE and affiliated to the Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, Kerala.

# 1.2 Amal Jyothi College of Engineering Eicher Center for Automobile Technology

In a first - of - its - kind venture for an engineering college in Kerala, Amal Jyothi College of Engineering has signed up an MOU with the globally renowned VE Commercial Vehicles Ltd (VECVL- a joint venture between the Volvo Group of Sweden and Eicher Motors Ltd.) and has started a center for Automobile Technology at Amal Jyothi campus.

The center will familiarize students on the latest automobile technology covering scientific ways of repair, maintenance and overhauling of commercial vehicles and Exposure to workshop operations, Customer Service management. VECVL will train the trainers and conduct regular follow-up programmes for the faculty. It will also provide study materials and training equipment for the course. The course will blend theory and practical sessions, and VECVL will provide internship at their dealerships across Kerala.

# 1.3 Automotive Technician Training Program

This Center is offering a highly job - oriented skill development course, Automotive Technicians Training Program. The course is recognized by Automotive Skill Development Council (ASDC).

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# **Criteria of Eligibility for Admission**

a. Academic Requirements : Pass in Class  $\mathsf{X}/\mathsf{ITI}$ 

b. Age: Below 23 yrs as on 01/06/16

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#### **Fee Structure**

Tuition Fee - Rs. 51000/- (Rupees fifty one thousand only).

Admission fee - Rs 100/Refundable caution deposit - Rs 2500/-

Identity card - Rs 100/- Driving Training - Rs 6000/- (optional)

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# **Procedure of Selection**

Eligible candidates will be called for an aptitude test at the Training Center. Rank list will be prepared based on marks in the aptitude test. Short listed candidates will be called for an interview prior to admission. Admission will be done on the basis of merit only.

# **How to Apply**

- a. Application forms for admission can be obtained from the College office in person on payment of Rs 250 /-. The forms can also be downloaded from the website of the College. Such applications have to be submitted along with a DD of Rs 250 /- in favour of the "Principal, Amal Jyothi College of Engineering", payable at Kanjirappally, or , in cash at the College office.
- b. The duly filled in application along with self attested copies of necessary documents are to be submitted directly or sent by registered post with A/D to the College so as to reach the office on or before the prescribed date.
- c. Applications submitted to the College should be complete in all respects.
- d. Self attested copies of the following certificates / documents have to be submitted along with the application.
  - 1. 10th certificate
  - 2. Mark lists / certificates of other qualifying examinations
  - 3. Copy of experience certificate, if any
  - 4. Recommendation letter from the parish priest(for Catholic students)
- e. Late and incomplete applications will be rejected.





# 7.5. Dress Code and Discipline

Students are to follow the college dress code (uniform) as prescribed. Anyone found violating the above instruction will be asked to leave the campus immediately and will lose the day's attendance. Students are to display their identity cards at all times when they are on the campus. They shall wear proper workshop dress of prescribed colour with safety shoes while doing practical sessions.

Students should conduct themselves in a polite and dignified manner. They are expected to look pleasant, neat and tidy. Gents shall cut their hair at normal intervals and they are expected to shave their face at least once in two days. They should avoid any adornment on their person, including dyes, beard, goatee etc.

Everyone is expected to keep the classrooms, workshops and the campus litter-free. Students should not use mobile phones and two-wheelers on the campus.

Smoking and consumption of intoxicants are strictly banned.



#### 7.6. Attendance

Trainees shall attend the theory and practical classes regularly as per the timetable. Prior permission shall be taken from the Training Coordinator for any leave in extreme urgency / medical grounds. Unauthorised absence will lead to termination of the traineeship.

#### 7.7. Evaluation

Performance will be evaluated regularly based on attendance, tests, assignments and records of workshop practice.

#### 7.8. Issue of certificate

On successful completion of the training programme including internship, certificate will be issued jointly by ACECAT and VECVL

#### 7.9. Bank and ATM

Extension counter and ATM of South Indian Bank are available inside the campus and ATM of Federal Bank is available at the main gate of the College.
